

OLD TOWN NORTH ALLIANCE ART AND CULTURE WALK PROJECT

The Old Town North Alliance (OTNA) hired Winstanley Architects to design an art walk in Old Town North inspired by the City of Alexandria's 2017 Old Town North Small Area Plan. The design includes the walk's route, key sites, and types of art sought; public area pavement markings, outdoor murals and sculptures on private property, and gallery views through the windows of old and new buildings. A fourth category of activation sites was also created. The Winstanley map was approved by the OTNA Board of Directors and presented to the Old Town North neighborhood, City of Alexandria staff, and Alexandria City Council members.

Following general approval of the proposal, the Old Town North Alliance moved forward on the next steps: a catalog of sites and desired works and an annual brochure to showcase existing and planned art installations.

The art walk promises to be a captivating journey for both visitors and residents, offering a blend of natural beauty and artistic expression that extends from the power generating station redevelopment site at Old Town North's north end to the Torpedo Factory Art Center near King Street. We thank the City for its early contributions to art in the neighborhood, and local developers and property owners for contributing works of art on their property.
